This deed, made the 19<sup>th</sup> day of February in the year 1852 between Murphy Hedgeseth of the one part and Thomas J. Bristol of the other part. Whereas that the said Murphy Hedgeseth doth grant unto the said Thomas J. Bristol, the following property to wit: one tract of land in the county of Southampton, containing one hundred and forty acres or the same more or less, also one horse, one feather bed & furniture, one large chest with drawers, one pair new cart wheels, 7 head of sheep, and 3 cows and their increase, 2 ploughs, 1 pair shear, 3 Tables, 1 Case, 3 flag bottom chairs, 1 desk, 2 dozen plates, 1 pot, 1 spider, 1 flying pan flea kettle, 600 lbs bacon, 25 barrels corn 2000 lbs blade fodder, 2 acres, 2 wagging hay, 1 Sub hoe, 1 pitch fork and 1 safe. In trust to secure the following debts due me by the said Murphy Hedgeseth, to wit: a debt due Mordecai Brasshaw for one hundred & fifty dollars by note due the 25<sup>th</sup> December 1849, another debt due the said Brasshaw for forty seven dollars, & fifteen cents by note due 4<sup>th</sup> February 1852 a debt due John Edwards for twenty one dollars by note due 30<sup>th</sup> December 1851, a debt due William Hedgeseth for twenty three dollars & sixty eight cents by note due 25<sup>th</sup> day of December 1850 a debt due Wm Hedgeseth for sixteen dollars due 1<sup>st</sup> day of January 1851, a debt due William Hedgeseth for eighteen dollars due the 25<sup>th</sup> December 1851, a debt due Milton D. Butler for Twenty six dollars & sixty cents by note executed the 8<sup>th</sup> day of March 1851, a debt due William S. & A. S. Stevenson for four dollars & 11/200 by note executed the 1<sup>st</sup> day of January 1852. Witness the following signatures & seals
