This deed, made the 19th day of February in the year 1852 between
Murphy Hedgpath of the one part and Thomas J. Brister of the other
part. Witnesseth that the said Murphy Hedgpath doth grant unto
the said Thomas Brister, the following property to wit: one tract of
land in the country of Southampton, containing one hundred and fifty
acres be the same more or less, also one horse, one feather bed
& furniture, one large chest with drawers, one pair new cast
wheels, 7 head of sheep, one cow and their increase, 2 ploughs, 1
iron chest, 3 tables, 1 case, 3 flag bottom chairs, 1 desk, 2 dozen
plates, 1 pot, 1 spider, 1 frying pan, 1 tea kettle, 600 lbs bacon
25 barrels corn 2000 lbs black fodder, 2 axes, 2 working hoes,
1 end hoe, 1 pitch fork and 1 saw. In trust to secure the following
debts due and owing by the said Murphy Hedgpath, to wit: a debt due
Mordcai Bradshaw for one hundred & fifty dollars by note due the 20th
December 1849, another debt due the said Bradshaw for forty
seven dollars, & fifteen cents by note due 4th February 1852 a debt
due John Edwards for twenty one dollars by note due 30th December
1851, a debt due William Hedgpath for twenty three dollars &
sixty eight cents by note due 25th day of December 1850 a debt due
John Hedgpath for sixteen dollars due 1st day of January 1851, a debt
due William Hedgpath for eighteen dollars due the 25th December 1850 a debt
due Milton D. Butler for twenty six dollars & sixty cents by note
received the 8th day of March 1851, a debt due William S. & A. S.
Stephenson for four dollars & 11/100 by note received the 1st day of
