Worrell of the said County, the receipt whereof we do hereby acknowledge, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said James G. Worrell his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land situated in the aforesaid County of Southampton bounded and described as follows, to-wit: On the East by Elthro Beale, South by Jacob Barnes, West by the said James Worrell, and North by the said James G. Worrell, beginning at a Black Gum a corner for Jethro Beale and a side line for Jacob Barnes, thence nearly west to a hickory thence nearly north-west to said James G. Worrell's line - containing by estimation Forty acres be the same more or less, and known as the old tract of land together with all the privileges and appurtenances to the said land in any wise appertaining and belonging. To have and to hold the above granted premises to the said Jas. G. Worrell his heirs and assigns forever, and I the said Jas. Worrell for myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, do covenant with the said James G.
