This Indenture made and entered into this 28th day of February A. D. 1852, between William Blew of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia, on the first part, and Wilson H. Darden of the aforesaid County and State on the second part, and Geo. W. Pete of the County of Hertford & State of North Carolina on the third part, witnesseth, that whereas the said William Blew is justly indebted to Geo. W. Pete, in the sum of one hundred and thirty two dollars and sixteen cents due by bond dated the 28th day of February A. D. 1852, and having interest from the date thereof, and whereas the aforesaid William Blew is willing and desirous to secure the payment of the above mentioned sum to Geo. W. Pete or his legal representatives: Now be it known to all whom it may concern, that in and in consideration of the premises and the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid by Wilson H. Darden Trustee the said William Blew hath given, granted, bargained & sold unto him the said Wilson H. Darden the following property, viz: One chestnut colored horse, one cart & wheels sixteen head of hogs, fourteen barrels of corn, three thousand weight of black fodder, two beds and covering & bedsteads, all my household & kitchen furniture of every description, one spinning wheel & cards, my entire stock of tools, harness, plowing gear and farming utensils and all the corn, fodder, peas, & cotton that I may make upon the premises or plantation upon which I now reside, save and except what may be necessary to pay the rent thereof for this present year of 1852 to him the said Wilson H. Darden, and his heirs forever. Upon trust nevertheless, that the said William Blew is to remain in quiet possession of all the aforesaid property until required by the said Geo. W. Pete or his legal representatives to be sold, whereupon it shall be the duty of the said Wilson H. Darden Trustee after advertising for ten days at least in three or more public places in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia to proceed to sell on credit of six months, all the aforesaid property herein enumerated and first pay the aforesaid sum with interest, cost &c. to the said Geo. W. Pete, and the costs of sale, commissions &c. and then pay the balance if any to said William Blew or his legal representatives.
