This Instrument, made the 20th day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand
eight hundred and forty six, between Benjamin Edmunds of Halifax County State
of North Carolina, on the one part, and Howell Edmunds of Henry County State
of Tennessee on the other part: Witnesseth that whereas, on the 15th day of
October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty, the said
Howell Edmunds of County and State aforesaid, for and in consideration of the sum of
Three thousand dollars to him in hand paid by the said Benjamin Edmunds
did sell and convey to the said Benjamin Edmunds a certain tract of land in the
County of Southampton, State of Virginia, bounded as follows, to wit: Beginning on
Mason's River where the Virginia line crosses the said River, thence up the meanders
of said River to where the Virginia line crosses the said River again, thence East with
the
