This Indenture, made and entered into on this 11th day of January year 1847, by and between Elizabeth Revel of the one part and Jacob Barnes of the other part, each party residing in the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia, This Indenture witnesseth, that the said Elizabeth Revel have for and in consideration of the sum of twenty dollars in hand paid by the said Jacob Barnes at the executing and delivery of these presents, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged and in consideration of which the said Elizabeth Revel have bargained and sold and do hereby grant, bargain and sell unto him the said Jacob Barnes all her interest in and to a certain lot or parcel of land lying in the aforesaid County of Southampton it being the identical land which Holaday Revel in 1841 his last will bequeathed to his son John Revel for life and at his death to the several children of the said John Revel supposed to contain about forty acres of land the matheth not whether there be more or less for him the said Jacob Barnes: To have and to hold free from the further claim of her the said Elizabeth Revel all free from the claim of all and every person or persons whomsoever with all the right, title, interest and estate which, she, the said Elizabeth Revel has heretofore held in and to the said lot or parcel of land to him the said Jacob Barnes his heirs and assigns forever, hereby warranting and will defend a fee simple title to said Barnes his heirs and assigns forever.
