Cottle, for and in consideration of the sum of forty dollars to them the said parties above named in hand well to and truly paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath granted, bargained, and sold and by these presents doth grant, bargain and sell unto the said Caswell Howell his heirs and assigns all those premises thirty two Acres of land well known by the Boundaries of Marked trees bounded by John Mypick's line, beginning at a big pine, thence to a branch pine, thence running a south course to a post, oak, thence along bearing towards the east to a forked black Gum, those are corner trees, also all trees, woods, underwoods, ways, water courses, profits, commodities advantages and appertinances whatsoever to the said messuages above mentioned belonging, or in any wise appertaining, and the reversion, remainder and inheritance, rents, issues and profits, of the said lands and premises and of every part and parcel thereof and all the estate, right, title, interest, claim & demand whatsoever of them the said Isiah Ellsworth, and wife Martha Ellsworth, Kirby Vick and wife Mariah Vick, Thomas Cottle and wife Sally C. Cottle, James Barnes, and wife Caroline Barnes and Joseph H. Ellsworth and wife Elizabeth Ellsworth unto the said messuages and every part thereof and all the estate thereof. To have & to hold the said messuages and all and singular the premises mentioned and every part and parcel thereof with their appertinances unto the said Caswell Howell his heirs and assigns forever, to the only proper use and behoof of the said parties named above for them and their heirs forever the said messuages and premises and every part thereof against him and his heirs and against all and every person and persons whatsoever to the said Caswell Howell his heirs and assigns shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents - In witness
