or before the making and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged, hath granted, bargained, sold and confirmed,
and by these presents doth grant, bargain, sell and confirm unto him
the said James Cutler his heirs and assigns forever, one certain
tract or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the aforesaid County
of Southampton containing two hundred and eighty acres for the same more
or less; adjoining the land of Matthew Wills, Jane Dutton &
James McElenny together with all the right, title, interest, claim or
demand of, in and to the above described tract or parcel of land
and premises with its appurtenances thereto belonging or in any
wise appertaining. To have and to hold the aforesaid tract or
parcel of land and premises, with all and singular its appurtenances
thereto belonging unto him the said James Cutler his heirs and assigns
forever, to and for the only proper use and behoof him the said James
Cutler his heirs and assigns forever, and the said Harrison S. Sope for
himself, his heirs, Executors, & assigns doth hereby covenant and agree
to and with the said James Cutler his heirs, Executors, administrators &
assigns that he will by these presents warrant and forever defend
the right and title of the aforesaid tract or parcel of land and premises
and every part or parcel thereof against the claims or demands of all
and every person or persons whatsoever.
