This deed made and entered into this third day of April year 1852, by and
between Jacob Barnes of the one part and Maxey Story of the other part
each of whom reside in the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia:
this deed witnesseth, that the said Jacob Barnes have - ft and
in consideration of the sum of four hundred dollars in hand paid by
the said Maxey Story at the delivery hereof and in consideration of which
the said Jacob Barnes have bargained and sold and by this deed do
grant, bargain and sell to him the said Story a certain portion of
land lying in the aforesaid County and in the 100th district of South-
Amey's parish and bounded as follows: Beginning at the road bet-
ween from the Piney Grove so called to the Cypress bridge which
road is as well a line for Richard Story as is Barnes at
the intersection of a ditch with a ditch at the edge of said
road, said intersecting ditch forming a drain down an east course
nearly a west course which ditch and drain is hereby made
a part of the boundary of the above named portion of land so far
at least as to where the waters of the millpond may ever hereafter
cover the lands then bounding on the edge of said highest water
that shall cover hereafter cover the adjacent lands up to the said
millpond to the Chappell road so called, then along said road
nearly an east course to the before named road bearing from the
Piney Grove to the Cypress bridge so called then along the said
