Bryant and Margaret his wife for themselves, their heirs, Executors, and assigns do and each of them doth hereby covenant and agree will by these presents warrant and forever defend all the right and title of the aforesaid tract or parcel of land and premises hereby conveyed against the claims or demands of all and every other person or persons whatsoever.
