And where as the said John M. Gurley has paid to the said Jazwell Taylor Receiver from the 16th day of August eighteen hundred and fifty when the same became payable as required by said decrees, which is hereby acknowledged by the said Jazwell Taylor, Receiver. Now therefore in consideration of the said payment and in compliance with and by virtue of the authority vested in him by the said decree herein last mentioned, the said Jazwell Taylor Commissioner specially appointed for that purpose, doth grant and convey unto the said John M. Gurley his heirs and assigns all that part of the Dept tract of land formerly belonging to Clement Rockelle as aforesaid which was appropriated to a survey as herein before mentioned supposed to contain twenty acres more or less, the residue of said tract which contained by an old survey one hundred and twenty five acres having been previously sold by said court as commissioner to Miles Strong and conveyed to him by the said Jazwell Taylor as commissioner under former decree pronounced in the suit herein referred to. To Have & To Hold the said tract of land with its appurtenances unto him the said John M. Gurley his heirs and assigns forever.
