Scott and Ann Mariah his wife for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred and forty six dollars in hand paid by the said W^m Murfee (the receipt is hereby acknowledged) doth grant, bargain and sell unto the said W^m Murfee his heirs and assigns forever, all of their right, title and interest of every description in the estate (or property of every description) which was granted to Emma Howell the late wife of Anthony M. Howell by the said A. M. Howell during her life and then given to her children or heirs, which right, title and interest the said Jonathan W. Scott & Ann Mariah his wife do and will warrant and defend unto the said W^m Murfee his heirs and assigns.
