of the other part. Witnesseth that whereas Wells Musfee by his last will
testament gave to Carr Bowers, Simon Musfee & J. D. Mafsenburg two thousand
Two hundred dollars to be invested in land and conveyed by them to the
said Martha Matilda Crumpler with the limitations and restrictions set forth
in said decedent's will and having heretofore executed their trust with the
exception of six hundred and sixty dollars, the said Carr Bowers and the
said J. D. Mafsenburg in their character of Trustees having received
possession of the here the tract of land formerly held by James Cromwell
at the price of six hundred and sixty dollars as will appear by
deed duly recorded to them. Now for and in consideration of the
premises and the further consideration of one dollar current

as aforesaid, have bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain
sell and convey unto the said Martha Matilda Crumpler wife of
