This Indenture made and entered into this 1st day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty two, between Harrison Beale and Tabitha his wife of the one part, and James Bradshaw of the other part, Witnesseth that the said Harrison Beale & Tabitha his wife for and in consideration of the sum of seventy five dollars current money of Virginia, to them in hand paid or secured to be paid by him the said James Bradshaw at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents, have bargain & sold, and by these presents both hereby bargain and sell unto the said James Bradshaw his heirs and assigns a certain tract of land lying and being in the county of Southampton containing by estimation twenty five acres or the same more or less and bounded as follows: By a new line beginning at a pine corner tree between Ben Cowens, John Coburn, and William Beale standing in a brush that crosses the Franklin road about one hundred yards or more above, running thence with this branch, in a southerly direction till it reaches Ben Cowens' line, and thence in all other sides to Ben Cowens' land. Said branch divides this tract from the original tract purchased of Henry Eby by said Harrison Beale this having been part of said tract, together with the reversion and reversions, remainder and remainders yearly and other issues and profits and every part and parcel thereof. To have and to hold the said tract of land with the tenements, hereditaments and all and singular the premises and appurtenances herebefore mentioned or intended to be bargain & sold with every part and parcel thereof unto the said James Bradshaw his heirs and assigns forever, and the said Harrison Beale and Tabitha his wife for themselves, and their heirs the said tract of land unto the said James Bradshaw his heirs and assigns against the claim of them the said Harrison Beale & Tabitha his wife and any person or persons claiming under them shall, will and do hereby warrant and forever defend by these presents.
