 Joseph Joyner of the one part and James Drury of the other part: that whereas the
 said James Drury by deed bearing date the 17th day of March 1843 and
 duly recorded on the 18th day of June 1843, conveyed to the said Alfred T.
 Stephenson one certain tract of land lying in the County of Southampton and
 bounded by the lands of A. S. W. Cuyler, M. Branch, Edwin Cuyler and
 Emma Branch containing 350 acres in trust to secure the payment of a bond
 due by the said James Drury to the said Joseph Joyner for the sum of \$309.
 74/100 bearing date March 23rd 1843, and also to secure the payment of a debt
 for which the said Joseph Joyner was his security due May 17th 1843 for
 the sum of \$141.59 and the said James Drury having discharged and paid
