Witnesseth that the said Nicholson & wife in consideration of the sum of four hundred dollars do grant unto the said Blanton a certain tract or parcel of land containing two hundred acres more or less bounded by the lands of Col. George Blow, Thomas Moom Jr. and Thomas J. Moom with the appurtenances thereto belonging; it being the same tract or parcel of land which was conveyed to said David W. Nicholson by deed from James E. Deas admitted to record in the Clerk's office of Southampton County the 21<sup>st</sup> day of January 1850. Witness the following signatures and seals:

This deed made and entered into the 17<sup>th</sup> day of January A. D. 1853, between Benjamin W. Blanton of the first part, Lethelton R. Edwards of the second part and David W. Nicholson of the third part. Witnesseth that the said Benjamin W. Blanton doth grant unto the said Lethelton R. Edwards all of a certain tract or parcel of land lying & being in the County of Southampton, containing two hundred acres be the same more or less and bounded by the lands of Col. George Blow, Thomas Moom Jr. and Thomas J. Moom - in trust to secure the payment of two bonds for the payment of money executed by the said Benjamin W. Blanton to the said David W. Nicholson on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of January 1853, one for the sum of two hundred dollars on demand the 17<sup>th</sup> day of January 1853, and the other for the sum of one hundred dollars on demand the 17<sup>th</sup> day of January 1853 - and both carrying interest from the date.
