This deed made the 31st day of January in the year 1853 between Susan Williams of the one part and James W. Parker and C. A. W. Newson of the other part. Witnesseth; that the said Susan Williams doth leave, demise, and grant unto the said James W. Parker and C. A. W. Newson, their personal representatives and assigns, the three rooms in her house in the Town of Franklin, now occupied by the firm of Williams & Markee in the transaction of the Mercantile business, known as the Stone room, the wine room (and the counting) room, together with the front and back cellars under said house, and also the shed room next to the street attached to the smoke house in the yard with fire ingrep & grapp to and from said room; to have and to hold from the 1st day of March 1853, for the term of four years then running, gilding) Therefor during the said term the rent of twenty five dollars per year payable annually; and the said Susan Williams for herself and heirs covenants that the said grantees shall have quiet possession of the property herein demised for the term aforesaid: And the said James W. Parker and C. A. W. Newson bind themselves and heirs to pay the rent as aforesaid. Witness the following signatures and seals.
