This deed made and entered into this 31st day of January 1853, between Thomas
 Drake and Thomas B. Worrell of the one part and Jonathan Darden of the other part:
 Whereas the said Thomas Drake being indebted unto Thomas N. Story in the
 sum of five hundred dollars due by five several bonds due on the 15th
 day of May 1848, by deed conveyed to Thomas B. Worrell a certain tract
 of land containing two hundred and three acres more or less being
 the land conveyed by Thomas N. Story & wife to said Drake by deed
 dated the 15th March 1848, and bounded by the lands of Edwin
 Hicks estate, Elijah Adams, Daniel A. Dringor's estate and others,
 in trust to secure the payment of the said sum of five hundred
 dollars. And whereas since the execution of the said deed by the
 said Drake, he the said Drake has paid off and discharged
 the said sum of five hundred dollars to the said Story, and
 hath made sale of the said tract of land to Jonathan Darden.
 Now therefore in consideration of the premises and of the sum of
 six hundred dollars to him the said Drake paid, he the said
 Drake with the consent and approbation of the said Thomas N. Story
 & Thomas B. Worrell signified by the said Worrell signing these
 presents, doth grant unto the said Jonathan Darden the aforesaid
 tract of two hundred and three acres bounded and described as above.
 And the said Worrell hereby releases unto the said Darden all
 right title or interest in or to the said tract of land which he the
 said Worrell has under the virtue of the deed of trust aforesaid.

 conveyed unto the said Jonathan Darden his heirs and assigns
