This deed made the 19th day of November 1852, between Jane A. Dutton, Ann Dutton, Mary Helen Dutton, W^m H. Summerville & Margaret his wife, Sarah D. Dutton, Julia C. Dutton, Joshua Dutton, Jordan S. Dutton and Samuel Bailey Dutton, of the one part and James W. McClenny of the other part; all of the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia: Witnesseth: that in consideration of the sum of four hundred and fifty dollars, the said Jane A. Dutton, Ann Dutton, Mary Helen Dutton, W^m H. Summerville, & Margaret his wife, Sarah D. Dutton, Julia C. Dutton, Joshua Dutton, Jordan S. Dutton and Samuel Bailey Dutton do grant unto the said James W. McClenny a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the said County of Southampton supposed to contain one hundred and ninety acres, more or less, (the same yard measured twelve by twenty yards square) which was devised to them by the late Thomas Dutton and being apart of the land purchased by him the said Thomas Dutton at a trust sale made by Thomas J. Dutton (the trustee) under a deed of trust made to him by James W.
