This deed made and entered into on the 2nd day of April year 1852, by and between Jacob Barnes of the first part and Lewis Vick of the second part, each party above named of the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia, this deed witnesseth, that the said Jacob Barnes have for and in consideration of the sum fifty hundred dollars to him said Barnes in hand paid at the so sealing and delivery of this deed, by the said Lewis Vick, the receipt thereof is hereby acknowledged in consideration of which he the said Barnes have bargained and sold of by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Lewis Vick, his wife and heirs, the house in which the keeper of said mill usually lives, with one acre of land lying immediately around said house, the in square form, the corner of the present paper being the boundary on the South side of said house, also the appurtenances to said mill being except all loose timbers either hewed or sawed lying near said mill, that fair, said Barnes reserves to his own use so be taken off at s^d Barnes's pleasure and further said Barnes permitted said Vick to take wood for fire &c. from off other of said Barnes's lands adjoining the lot or parcel of land above named &c. except such as is suitable for fence rails, so fair of said

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
