This deed made and entered into this 18th day of August, A.D. 1853, between Harrison P. Pope, and Richard Darden. Whereas William Vick on the 1st day of August 1851, being indebted unto Elizabeth A. Vick in the sum of four hundred and thirty six dollars due by him several bonds, ad. for the purpose of securing the payment thereof, convey to Harrison P. Pope the tract of land wherein the said William Vick lived containing one hundred acres more or less: also the tract or parcel of land which he the said William Vick had lately purchased of Harrison P. Pope containing two hundred and thirty and two third acres by late survey, with power and authority to the said Pope at any time after the 1st day of August 1853 first giving Ten days previous notice to sell at Public auction, one of the said tracts or parcels of lands for cash and apply the proceeds insofar as directed in said deed. And whereas the said Harrison P. Pope in virtue of the power of authority vested in him by said deed after having given ten days notice thereof, did on the 6th day of August 1853, set up and sell at public auction for cash the tract of land above mentioned containing two hundred and thirty $\frac{2}{3}$ acres, and Richard Darden became the purchaser thereof at the price of four hundred and one dollar, which was the highest bid made for the same. Now therefore the said Harrison P.
