every the appurtenances therunto belonging or in any wise appertain-
ing and we do hereby covenant and with the said L. S.
Dowell that we have before the execution of this deed full
right, absolute and lawful authority to sell the said land
and premises, and agree hereby to warrant and forever defend
the right, and title of the same to him the said Littleton S. Dowell
