Hanson Crump doth grant unto the said Edward D. Phillips his heirs and assigns all his interest in the land belonging to Edwin Ricks including his interest in the dower land now in the possession of Nathl D. Phillips who married Mrs. Maria Ricks the widow of Edwin Ricks, also his interest in the Mth whole land which was bought by Nathl. D. Phillips from W^m H. Darden for the benefit of his wards, Caroline P. Ricks and Virginia E. Phillips who was Virginia E. Ricks, containing by estimation four hundred acres, be the same more or less, which extend the said R. Hanson Crump doth hereby warrant and forever defend the title thereto to the said Edward D.
