This Deed, made this 30th day of September in the year 1853, between Mary A. White of the one part and John S. Kindred of the other part: Witnesseth that the said Mary A. White doth grant unto the said Mrs. Kindred the following personalty, to wit: the tract of land on which the said White now resides containing about one hundred and sixty acres or all of her interest therein, three old negroes and Johnson and Grace, two horses and their increase, two cows of one calf and their increase, one yoke of Oxen, Stock of hogs about thirty in number and their increase, fifteen sheep of their increase, thirty geese and their increase, two carts and pair of wheelers, four plows of the plow horse eight breeding hoes, two gutting hoes, one still, two cider presses, 130 cider casks, 40 barrels of beer, 1200 pounds bacon, parcel of peas, 25 pounds cotton, 5 beds, furniture, clothing and bedsteads, 1 sideboard, 4 tables, 3 benches, 1 desk, 2 chests, 14 chairs, 2 looking glasses, 18 plates, 12 cups and saucers, 6 dishes, 12 spoons, 4 waiters, 2 sad-irons, 1 loom & gear, 5 pots, 1 kettle, 1 frying pan, 3 spiders, 1 oven, 4 trays, 4 trays, six pails, 2 tubs, 2 spinning wheels, 3 pair cards, 1 block, about fifteen hundred pounds blade fodder, 3 axes. The said White further grants to the said Kindred all of his crops of all kinds now planted, growing or standing in the fields, to wit: entire crop of corn, cotton, potatoes, peas, fodder &c. In trust all of the foregoing property is granted to secure the payment of the following debts due from the said White to the parties named, to wit: a bond due to Clarke & Pope for \$51.87 cents dated & on demand the 24th of April A.D. 1851, and a debt due to Wm. J. School for about \$70.00 upon which an action has been brought in one of the courts of Southampton County, and is now pending. The said two debts to Clarke & Pope and Wm. J. School to be paid first and then the following debts to be paid pro rata, to wit: one bond due Elizabeth M. Blunney for \$29.43 dated May 29th 1843, also another bond due the same for \$17.29 dated June 19th A.D. 1850, an open account or note for about \$38.25 cents due to Alfred Parks, an open account due to Alexander Conflit or a note for about \$45.00, and an open account or note due to Harrison D.
