Moore of the County & State aforesaid of the other part, Witnesseth Virginia to them in hand said is secured to be paid by the said William D. Moore at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the sum of one hundred & eighty dollars lawful money of Virginia to them in hand said is secured to be paid by the said William D. Moore all the land that is called the Dins woods containing by estimation eighty acres be the same more or less and bounded by William D. Moore, Letterson Moore, Nancy Bouten & others.
