This Indenture, made the 16th day of August eighteen hundred and fifty three, between Wiley Lankford and Rebecca Lankford of the one part, and William Lankford Jr. of the other part: witnesseth, that the said Wiley Lankford and Rebecca Lankford in consideration of the sum of Sixty five dollars and of Land money of the Commonwealth to them in hand paid by the said William Lankford Jr. at or before the inscating and delivering of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged. Have bargained and sold and by these presents do and each of them both bargained and sold unto the said William Lankford Jr. his heirs and assigns all our right, the interest in our father's Zachariah Lankford land lying & being in the County of Southampton and adjoining the land of Jacob Hobbs, Sixth People, Patrick Rose, and William Wester, together with all their rights and privileges, profits, emoluments, commodities and appurtenances whatsoever to the said land belonging or pertaining to with the same used, enjoyed or accepted, uppon taken to known as part, parcel or member thereof, or as belonging to the same or any part thereof and the reversion and reversionary, remainder and remainders yearly and otherwise of every part and parcel thereof. To have and to hold their said right in Zachariah Lankford land with the premises hereinbefore mentioned intended to be bargained of sold and ready part and parcel thereof, with every of their rights, members and appurtenances unto the said William Lankford Jr. his heirs and assigns forever, to the only proper use and behoof of him the said William Lankford his heirs and assigns forever. And the said Wiley Lankford, Rebecca Lankford, in witness thereof, their heirs the said right, title and interest in Zachariah Lankford land with all and singular the premises &c. unto the said William Lankford his heirs and assigns free from the claim or claims of them the said Wiley Lankford and Rebecca Lankford or either of them their or either of their heirs and of all and every other person or persons whatsoever shall, will and do warrant and forever defend by these presents.
