Witnesseth, that the said Wiley Lankford and Rebecca Lankford in consideration of the sum of fifty five dollars and of Lankford's money of this Commonwealth to them in hand paid of the said William Lankford Jr. at or before the sealing and delivery of the said indenture (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have bargained, sold, aliened, conveyed and by these presents do and each of them doth bargain and sell unto the said William Lankford Jr. his heirs and assigns all our right, title and interest in our father's Zachariah Lankford land (being in the County of Southampton and adjoining the land of James Hobbs, Rich^d Peale, Patrick Rowe, and William Wester, together with all their rights, and privileges, profits, emoluments, commodities and appurtenances) which dover to the said Land belonging or appertaining or with the same used, enjoyed or accepted, reputed, taken or known as part, parcel or member thereof, or as belonging to the same or any part thereof and the reversion and reversions, remainders and remainders, greatly and other rents and of every part and parcel thereof. To have and to hold their said right in Zachariah Lankford land with the premises hereinbefore mentioned and intended to be bargained & sold and every part and parcel thereof, with every of their rights, members and appurtenances unto the said William Lankford Jr. his heirs and assigns forever, to the only proper use and behoof of him the said William Lankford his heirs and assigns forever. And the said Wiley Lankford, Rebecca Lankford, for themselves, their heirs the said rights, titles and interest in Zachariah Lankford land with all and singular the premises &c. unto the said William Lankford his heirs and assigns free from the claim or claims of them the said Wiley Lankford and Rebecca Lankford or either of them their or either of their heirs and of all and every other person or persons whatsoever, shall, will and do warrant and save defend by these presents.
