Brantley for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars
to them in hand paid by sd W^m B. Brantley the receipt of which
is hereby acknowledged, all the right, title and interest which they
have or hold in (a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being
in the County of Southampton (and on which said Brantley now resides
containing one hundred & eighty acres more or less and bounded on one side
by the lands on which the road leading from Cooper's Store to
Jones bridge and joining the tract of land in which Phila Rollings
now resides.) so have and to hold the sd tract or parcel of land for
from the claim of him the sd Rollings and wife and all and every
person whatsoever to the only use and behoof of him the sd W^m
