Moore & Virginia W. his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred & fifty dollars to them in hand paid by the said W^m S. McGe at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) they the said W^m P. Moore & Virginia W. his wife have granted, bargained, and sold unto the said W^m S. McGe his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land lying in the aforesaid County, and adjoining the lands of W^m Ellis, Nancy Austin, Lawrence Gardner, & others: containing thirty four acres more or less. To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land unto the said W^m S. McGe his heirs and assigns forever. And the said W^m P. Moore and Virginia W. his wife for them selves and their heirs the said tract or parcel of land unto the said W^m S. McGe his heirs and assigns free from the claim or claims of the said W^m P. Moore & Virginia W. his wife, or either of them, their or either of their heirs & of all and every other person or persons whatsoever.
