Dolos trustee of the other part, Witnesseth that the said Warren Edwards and Martha his wife doth do grant unto the said Robert M. Dolos the trustee the following property: One tract of land, containing six hundred and fifty acres be the same more or less, bounded as follows: lying in the fork of Netoway Swamp and Netoway River, on the north by the Lands of Bennett and Robert Serrus and Arthur Gardner.
