This Indenture made and entered into on the 30th day of March in the year of our said Eighteen hundred and fifty four, between Amos Copeland and Louisa his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part, and Watson Howell of Guilford County State of North Carolina of the other part. Witnesseth; that for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and ninety three dollars thirty seven & half cents current money of the Commonwealth of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said Watson Howell at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, Have granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain and sell unto him the said Watson Howell his heirs and assigns forever, one certain tract or parcel of land Situate, lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and parish of Saint Luke's, containing by a late Survey one hundred and ten and half acres to the same more or less, and bounded as follows, to wit: Beginning at a post standing in the Virginia and North Carolina line, also in William Wiggins line a new corner for the said Watson Howell and Amos Copeland, thence along the States line and said Wiggins line West 11 poles to a pine, thence N. 69° W. 69 poles to a pine corner for Esman M. Bryant, thence along his line N. 20° W. 20 poles to a pine, thence N. 43° W. 55 poles to a pine (near a branch) thence N. 25° W. 9 poles to a pine stump, thence N. 23° E. 12 poles to a red oak, thence N. 5° W. 33 poles to a white oak, thence N. 3° E. 6 poles to a post oak, thence N. 43° W. 27 poles to a white oak, thence
