This Indenture made this 17th day of April in the year 1854, between
Seth D. Williams, commissioner of the one part and John St. Bishop of the
other. Whereas the County Court of Southampton did by its decree entered
at the Term of the said Court direct the sale of the tract of land belonging
to the heirs of Edwin Harrison dec'd lying in the County of Southampton, contain-
ing about two hundred and eighty acres and whereas at the sale John
St. Bishop became the purchaser. Now therefore this Indenture witnesseth
that for and in consideration of the sum of nine hundred and seven dollars
to the said Seth D. Williams in hand paid at and before the sealing
(and delivery) of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
by the said Seth D. Williams hath granted, bargained and sold
(and by these presents does grant, bargain and sell unto the said John St.
Bishop to him and his heirs forever a tract of land lying in the
County of Southampton, containing two hundred and eighty acres more or
less and bounded on the north and west by the lands of John
Johnson, South by the lands belonging to the heirs of William
Butler, and east by the Northway sides of the said land being the
land formerly owned by Edwin Harrison and sold under decree.
And the said Seth D. Williams does hereby warrant unto the said John St.
Bishop the title conveyed to him and vestible in him by the above-
said decree of the County Court of Southampton. In Witness whereof, he has
