

This Deed made this twenty sixth day of May in the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty four, between William D. Clarke, his wife Cyra A. Clarke and Harrison P. Pope of the first part, and George C. Pope of the other part, Witnesseth that the said Clarke, his wife Cyra and H. P. Pope (grantors as aforesaid) do hereby bargain, sell, grant, and convey to the said George C. Pope grantee and to his heirs forever all that lot or lots together with all the buildings thereon of every kind, whatsoever and with all the appurtenances and privileges thereto attached in the Town of Jerusalem county of Southampton, containing there across more or less and bounded by the public Street, by the Court Square by the Nottingham river and by Oliver's row (formerly called Cooley's row) it being the whole of the said property conveyed by James B. Myghart & wife & others to the said Clarke by deed admitted to probate in the ninth day of April A.D. 1847, and being the same lot on which the said Clarke formerly resided. The said conveyance and grant is now made for and in consideration of the sum of fifteen hundred dollars (\$1500.00) by the said George C. Pope in hand paid to the said Clarke & wife of H. P. Pope, the receipt of which sum is hereby acknowledged by them. And it has not been forgotten by the parties to this deed that the said William D. Clarke, did & does dated December 31st A.D. 1851, and admitted to record on the 16th day of February A.D. 1852, settle and convey to Harrison P. Pope as trustee for the parties (and for their benefit the particulars of which are described & specified in the said deed the property above mentioned. But the above conveyance to the said George C. Pope is made at the special instance and by the express wish, desire and approbation of the said Cyra A. Clarke and the purchase money received therefor is appropriated as the said parties have directed. And the said grantors warrant generally and specially the property hereby conveyed.
