

Know all men by these presents, that I, Martha Chitty of the county of Southampton and State of Virginia, for and in consideration of the natural love and affection which I bear to my children Benjamin St. Chitty, Sarah E. Chitty, Melvina A. Chitty, and Sophronia Chitty, all of Southampton and State of Virginia as well as for the further consideration of one dollar to me in hand paid by my said children at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, I have given and granted and by these presents do give and grant unto my said children above named their executors, administrators and assigns, two beds, and furniture, one shot gun, one lawn one spinning wheel and pair cards, in safe, two chests, half dozen chairs, three pots, one spider and corn, two tables, foot rack, five songs, broad hoe and shovel, one axe and three weeding hoes, one coffee mill, 8 plates, 2 sets cups and saucers, 1 dish, Vinegar cruet, pepper box 1 coffee pot, 1 set of knives and forks, 1 do. 2 sheets and their increase to have, and to hold the property above given to my children previously named their executors, administrators and assigns forever. And the said Martha Chitty for herself, her executors, and administrators the said property unto her children their executors, administrators and assigns against the claim of her the said Martha Chitty, her executors, and administrators and against the claim or claims of all and every person or persons whatsoever, shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents.
