This deed made the 15th day of July 1854, between Seth R. Strong on the one part and Isaac Cox on the other part: Witnesseth: that in consideration of the sum of Five hundred and fifty dollars the said Seth R. Strong, doth grant unto the said Isaac Cox all his his claims upon a certain tract of land (except a certain privilege reserved by Littleton R. Edwards to the use of the well) lying near Jerusalem, it being a part of the Melik's tract bounded on the North by the road leading from Jerusalem to Jones bridge on the east, by the Copperas bridge road, and on the South and west by the lands of the estate of James Dockell sen. Containing by estimation five acres be the same more or less together with all the appertinances. And the said Seth R. Strong, for himself and his heirs the said parcel of land unto the said Isaac Cox his heirs (and assigns free from the claims of all persons whatsoever now or hereafter warrant and defend by these presents. In Witness whereof, I have hereunto set my hand and seal, this 15th day of July 1854.
