This deed made the 25th day of May in the year 1851, between Edwards Rutledge and Archibald Atkinson and Elizabeth A. his wife of the one part (and Jason Council of the other part: Witnesseth: that in consideration of the sum of one hundred and four dollars the said Rutledge and Atkinson wife, do grant unto the said Jason Council a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton, containing one hundred and four acres more or less (and bounded as follows: Beginning at a post oak in Ann Gray's line, thence along his line N 87¹/₂ W. 25¹/₂ poles to a small post oak, thence along said Rutledge & Atkinson's line N 34¹/₂ W. 20 poles to a pine, thence N 30¹/₂ W. pole to a pine, thence N 28¹/₂ W. 16 poles to a holly standing branch, thence down the run of said Branch 1 1/4 poles to another oak standing in another branch, (at the fork of the branches) thence down said branch to the Horse pen Swamp, thence down the
