This Deed made this 11th day of August in the year 1854 between Oran Vaughan of the one part and Thomas Harman of the other part, both of the County of Southampton, Virginia; (and assigning) the lands of Matthew W. Vaughan, the heirs of Anthony Vaughan dec'd and others, containing one hundred and fifty acres, more or less, one bay horse, six head of cattle, and increase, fifteen head of hogs and increase, all of this growing crop of corn, fodder, peas, potatoes, cotton &c. All of his household & kitchen furniture, viz: four beds and furniture, chairs, desk, side board, Walnut table, crockery ware of all kinds, pine tables, knives & forks cooking utensils, of every kind, farming utensils &c including all of said O. Vaughan's estate of every kind and sort, in trust, to secure, to William Murphy or his order or assigns the payment of a note executed by the said Oran Vaughan to the said W. Murphy or order, dated (and on demand with interest from the 11th day of August 1854) for seven hundred and fifty five dollars. And the said Oran Vaughan covenants with the said Thomas Harman that he will warrant generally the title to said property against the claims of all persons whatsoever.

Denson, all her right and interest in the estate of Thomas B. Williamson dec'd, that is, her undivided interest in the land now directed to be sold, and her undivided interest in the dower land and slaves now held by the heirs of said Thomas B. Williamson dec'd.

Aubrey has in possession of two hundred and thirty
