This Deed made this 14th day of Sept. A.D. 1854, between Harrison P. Pope, and Edward Beaton.
Whereas the said Pope by virtue of the powers vested in him by a certain deed of Trust exec-
uted on the 4th day of August 1851, by William Vick for the purpose of securing the
payment of a debt due Elizabeth A. Vick - which said deed was admitted to record
on the said 4th day of August 1851, did, after giving at least ten days notice thereof,
on the 26th day of Augt 1854, sell at public Auction for cash, a tract of land
conveyed by the said deed and described therein as, "the lands wherein he the said William
