Blow, hath given, granted, bargained, sold, aliened, conveyed, released, and confirmed (and by these presents doth give, grant, bargain, sell, alien, convey, release, and confirm to the said Davis Barrett his heirs and assigns forever) my crop, of corn, fodder, peas, potatoes, cotton, sixteen head of hogs (and their increase, one horse, buggy & harness, two plows & gear, four plow hoes, two axes, four wood hoes, two beds & furniture, four tables, one clock, one case, one buffet, four looking glasses, thirty book. To have and to hold the said hereby is intended to be hereby granted crop of corn, fodder, peas, potatoes, sixteen head of hogs, {their increase, one horse, buggy & harness, two plows & gear, four plow hoes, 2 axes, 4 wood hoes, two beds & furniture, 4 tables, one clock, one case, buffet 4 looking glasses, thirty book, hereby conveyed unto said Davis Barrett, his heirs, execs, admors, and assigns forever. And the said Nathl R. Blow for himself, his heirs, execs, admors and assigns doth hereby covenant promise and agree to and with the said Davis Barrett his heirs, executors, admors and assigns that he will by these presents warrant and forever defend the right and title of the aforesaid named property hereby conveyed, against the claims or demands of all person or persons whatsoever.
