This Deed of Bargain and Sale made this day of 1853, from John Whitehead and wife Mary Whitehead to Peter Jackson (for) all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia. Whereas the said John Whitehead and Mary Whitehead his wife for and in consideration of the sum of fifty eight Dollars to them paid by the said Peter Jackson, hath granted, bargained and sold to the said Peter Jackson, a certain tract or parcel of land lying in the aforesaid County of Southampton containing twenty nine acres or there abouts more or less and adjoining the Lands of Peter Edwards. The said John Whitehead and Peter Jackson with these conditions that the said Peter Jackson binds himself to allow the said John Whitehead and Mary Whitehead his wife to keep open a certain ditch that has been sunk through said tract of land at all times. The right and title of said tract or parcel of land the said John Whitehead and Mary his wife warrants and defends to the said Peter Jackson against the claims and demands of all and every person or persons what soever. In witness whereof we John Whitehead and Mary Whitehead have hereunto set our hands and affixed our seals, the day and year above written.
