 demand, and nine hundred Dollars two years after date, the said Geo. W.
 Gurley doth convey and warrant the title generally unto the said Jas. A.
 Gillett his heirs & assigns to a certain tract of Land known as the horse tract containing six
 hundred and twenty five acres more or less and bounded on the north by the lands of
 Wm. J. Seibert, East by the Adamsville Swamp, South by the Russell tract and
 the tract sold by Geo. W. Gurley to William Bradshaw, but now belongs to

This Deed made the seventh day of January (1855) in the year eighteen hundred and
 fifty four, between Harman Abner & Marcella his wife of Isle of Wight County, Virginia,
 of the first part, and Asaiah B. Vaughan of the other part of Southampton County
 Virginia, Winchester; that in consideration of the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars
 in hand paid by the said Vaughan to the said Abner, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
 by the said Harman Abner & Marcella his wife, the said Abner doth grant, bargain sell and
 convey unto the said Asaiah B. Vaughan of his heirs forever a certain piece
 of land situated in said County, bounded on the North and east by the lands
 of Harman Abner, on the North west by lands formerly belonging to Geo. Stitt, but now
 the property of said Vaughan & on the west by the said A. B. Vaughan's
 portion of the original "Abner tract" and containing about eighty nine (89) acres
 or thereabouts more or less. To have and to hold the same to him the said Asaiah B.
 Vaughan and his heirs forever, and the said Harman Abner for himself and his heirs
 does covenant to and with the said Asaiah B. Vaughan and his heirs, that he, the
 said Abner has a perfect and undivided right & title to the said land in fee simple
 & that he has the right and does convey the same to the said Vaughan & his
 heirs; & that he does and will and his said heirs shall warrant generally
 the property hereby conveyed to the said A. B. Vaughan and his heirs
