 second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and have lawfully
 and sold unto the said party of the second part, one tract or parcel of
 land lying, situated and being in the County of Southampton of State of
 Virginia, and bounded as follows by the lands of said Levi Stephenson
 on the east, by the rent of the Light wood swamp on the South and on the
 North and west by the lands of J. Carol and J. T. Murrell
 containing one hundred acres being a part of the land formerly belonging to
