This Indenture, made and executed this 15th day of February One thousand
eight hundred and fifty five, Between Wm Lankford of the County of Southampton
of the first part, James H. Councill of the adjacent County of Southampton fellow
part and Patrick Rose of the said County of the third, all the said parties
residing in the State of Virginia: Whereas both, that the said James H.
Councill is bound in abond^t as security with the said Wm Lankford, the
sum of Two hundred dollars bearing date next
day of 1854, more fully appears which debt with the legal
interest thereon accruing, the said Wm Lankford is willing and desirous
to remit. Now this Indenture witnesseth that for (and in consideration
of the premises and also for the further consideration of one dollar of
lawful money of Virginia to the said Wm Lankford in hand paid by the said
Patrick Rose (the trustee) at and before the sealing (and delivery) of these
present, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, to the said Wm Lankford
both given, granted, bargained, sold, aliened, enfeoffed, released and confirmed; unto
these presents both you, grant, bargain, sell, alien, enfeoff, release and confirm
to the said Patrick Rose his heirs and assigns forever that 150 acres of land
formerly belonging to Zachariah Lankford my father living and being in the County
of Southampton, containing in the whole 150 acres more or less and bounded
as follows, to wit: east by the lands of James Holmes, North by the lands
of Shadrach Hale, west and south by the lands of Patrick Rose, and to
the latter with all and singular the appurtenances to the said tract of land
lands belonging or in any wise appertaining to the said tract or parcels of
land belied to me in my wife appertaining and will the right, title and interest
of the said Wm Lankford, in and to the said granted or intended to hereby
granted tract a parcel of land and premises. To have and to hold the said
hereby granted or intended to be hereby granted tract a parcel of land
and premises with its appurtenances together with all ge unto the said
Patrick Rose his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever to the my
proper use and behoof of the said Patrick Rose his heirs, executors, administrators
and assigns forever. And the said Wm Lankford for himself his heirs,
executors and administrators doth hereby covenant, promise (and agree to make)
with the said Patrick Rose his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns
forever in manner and form following, that is to say; that the said Wm Lankford,
his heirs, executors, and administrators the aforesaid tract or parcel
of land and premises with their appurtenances unto the said Patrick Rose
his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns against all persons whatever
shall and will aught and forever defend of these presents. Upon trust never
theless that the said Patrick Rose his heirs executors and administrators shall
cause the said Wm Lankford to remain in quiet and peaceable possession of
the said tract a parcel of land and premises with its appurtenances and to
the profits thereof to his own use until default be made in the payment
of the said sum of two hundred dollars in the whole or in part, and also
upon this further trust that the trustee or the survivor shall and will
as soon after the happening of such default of payment as he or his heirs
