eth; that in consideration of the sum of Three hundred Dollars in hand the receipt  
whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said Jno. W. Gailey doth convey unto the said  
Jeppe Little a certain piece of land containing twenty one third acres more  
less and bounded as follows: Beginning at a Sweet gum tree int William  
Le Cavelier's Lane, the said tree being a corner for the aforesaid Jno. W. Gailey  
William Le Cavelier's line; from thence a South East course to a Red oak a line  
for Jno. W. Gailey and William Le Cavelier in the aforesaid Jeppe Little's  
line; thence to a Crooked pine, a corner for Jno. W. Gailey and Jeppe  
Little in the Le Cavelier line; thence to a Sweet Gum a corner for the Le Cavelier
