This Indenture, made this twentieth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty five, between Alfred Holmead, of the County of Baltimore in the State of Maryland, and Elizabeth Holmead his wife of the one part and Charles Mortimer of the same place of the other part, Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of Ten thousand Dollars lawfully money of the United States to the said parties heirs of the first part paid by the party of the second part to them presents at or before the sealing and delivery hereof the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said Alfred Holmead and Elizabeth Holmead his wife, have granted, bargained and sold, aliened, conveyed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, alien, convey and convey unto the above named Charles Mortimer, his heirs, assigns, administrators and assigns. All that tract or parcel of Land lying sit Blackwater River, containing Seven hundred acres, more or less in Southampton County, Virginia, (commencing about Four or Two and a quarter miles on the County road leading from Franklin Depot to Jerusalem being the same tract of Land conveyed by one D. Clair Brown to certain Joseph H. Smith by Deed dated on or about the twentieth day of December Eighteen hundred and fifty two and subsequently conveyed by Deed from said Smith and Mary his wife to one Alfred Holmead by Deed bearing date subsequently to August the first Eight hundred and fifty four; together with as embraced in last mentioned Deed said parcel, in the Records of Southampton County, Virginia, at Jerusalem, the County Court the property known as the Franklin Stream and Mill embracing the same Virginia, Railways &c. likewise two Saw Mills located at Franklin Depot on the Land conveyed by one Richard Barrett to the said Joseph Smith.
