Eighteen hundred and fifty five, between Edward C. Crumpler of the County of
Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Joshua Crumpler of the
same County and State of the other part: Witnesseth that the said Edward C.
Crumpler for and in consideration of the natural love and affection which he
bears to the said Joshua Crumpler as well as for the further consideration
of one dollar (to him in hand paid by the said Joshua Crumpler at and before
the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged,
both legal, granted, bargained and sold and of their mutual debt, give, grant, bargain
and sell unto the said Joshua Crumpler his heirs and assigns forever one certain
tract or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and
parish of Saint Luke's, containing by Survey three hundred and fifty acres be the
same more or less it being the tract or parcel of land whereon the said Joshua
Crumpler now resides and was purchased by said Edward C. Crumpler from
Henry Jones and wife and bounded by the Lands of Robert S. Harris, John S.
Gratham, John Goodling dec^d and others: To have and to hold the above described
tract or parcel of land and premises, with all and singular the appurtenances thereto
belonging or in any way appertaining unto him the said Joshua Crumpler
his heirs and assigns forever to and for the sole proper use and behoof of him the
said Joshua Crumpler his heirs and assigns forever. And the said Edward C.
Crumpler for himself, his heirs, Executors administrators both hereby covenant
and agree to and with the said Joshua Crumpler his heirs, Executors,
Administrators and assigns, that he will by these presents warrant and
forever defend all the right and title of the aforesaid tract or parcel of land
and premises with the appurtenances thereto belonging against the claims
or demands of all and every other person or persons whatsoever. In witness
