This Deed made this 16th day of April 1855, between Benjaⁿ H. Travis, master of the first part and Swin Griffin, trustee of the second part, witnesseth, that the said Benjaⁿ H. Travis do grant unto the said Swin Griffin trustee the following property viz: two horses, six head of cattle and their increase, sixteen head of hogs and their increase, one cart and wheels, all my household and kitchen furniture, consisting of beds, chairs, tables, safe, pots, pans, kettles, yarning wheels also my other property that is or may come unto my estate all in trust to secure a certain debt or bond due Demareus L. Dolus bearing date 3rd of March 1855, for one hundred and sixty one dollars and 40/100 in demand, interest from date and we further covenant and agree should the said Demareus L. Dolus request the said Swin Griffin trustee, to sell the property above named, he shall have the power to do so by giving ten days notice. In witness whereof, the parties have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals this day and year first above written.
