This Deed made this 21st day of May 1855, between Mansfield Hines of the one
part and Lillieton S. Edwards of the other part, Witnesseth, that the said Mans-
field Hines hath grant unto the said Edwards a certain tract or parcel of
land lying and being in the County of Southampton containing by late Survey two
hundred and ninety six acres more or less being the same tract or parcel of land conveyed
to said Hines by Archibald Atkinson & wife of Edwards Sells by deed dated 18th March
1853. In trust to secure the payment of two bonds made payable to Archibald
Atkinson & the other to Edwards Sells for one hundred & sixty six dollars & fifty
cents dated the 31st March 1853, & not demand twelve months after date. And
the said Mansfield Hines covenants with the said Edwards that he will
warrant generally the property above conveyed.

This Indenture made and returned into this 19th day of May 1855, between
Richard C. Gray of the first part, John Barkham of the second part and Pope
Wright of the third part, all of the County of Southampton and State of
Virginia. Whereas the said Richard C. Gray is indebted to the said Pope
& Wright by bond bearing date the 18th day of May 1853, in the sum of
three hundred and seventy two dollars and ninety two cents, also one other bond
bearing date the first day of March 1854, for four hundred and twenty five
dollars subject to a payment made January the 1st 1855. And the said
Richard C. Gray being willing and desirous to secure the repayment of the
said debt and interest. He has this Indenture Witnesseth that he and in consideration of the
sum of money and for the further consideration of one dollar to him the said Richard
C. Gray in hand paid by the said John Barkham at and before the
making and delivery of this present, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged,
gives, grants, conveys, assigns, transfers, bargains and sells to the said John Barkham
his heirs and assigns forever, the following property, to wit: his present pro-
ceeding crop of Corn, garden, peas, cotton, &c. potatoes. To have and hold
to him the said John Barkham proper use and behoof forever, upon trust
nevertheless that the said John Barkham shall at the request of either
one of the aforesaid parties after giving at least ten days notice of the time and
place of Sale, sell at public auction all the property herein named as a whole thing
as shall be sufficient to satisfy said debt and interest and out of the proceeds first
pay the expenses thereof, then pay Pope & Wright's debt with interest and the balance
