Witnesseth that the said William E. Beale, Executor as aforesaid

the 20th day of December 1853, sell to the highest bidder, one third part
of the mill owned by said Elijah Joyner and Joseph Britt and said John
E. Beale, and the said Elijah Joyner and Joseph Britt became the pur-
