This Indenture made the 6<sup>th</sup> day of September in the year of our Lord 1855 between Morrison R. Joyner and wife of the first part and Carr Holland of the second part, all of the County of Southampton and Isle of Virginia. Whereas, that the said Morrison R. Joyner and wife for and in consideration of the sum of Two thousand dollars, has bargained and by these presents doth grant, bargain sell and deliver to the said Carr Holland his heirs and assigns forever a certain tract of Land to the Melvin Depot tract of land containing Two hundred and thirty acres more or less bounded by the lands of John Whitehead Marks, etc. and others with all and every the appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining. And we do hereby covenant to and with the said Carr Holland that we have before the execution of this deed full right and absolute and lawful authority to sell the said land and promises and agree hereby to warrant and forever defend the right of title of the same to him, the said Carr Holland his heirs and assigns forever; in witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands and seals the day and year above written.
